LGLTC External Competitions

The Playing Committee enter a number of external competitions for the members of LGLTC to play in. The competitions that are entered are reviewed annually by the PC to confirm suitability for club needs.

The objectives and captains for each of these teams are displayed on the PC notice board and published on the website.

Selection for these squads is made by the Ladies' and Men's Captains with input from the coaching team as required by the captains. Identification of potential players is made through internal competitions (boxes, club closed etc), coaching and ladies' and men's drills.

Summer Leagues - weekend

- **National Cup** – 1 ladies' and 1 men's team, a knockout competition, 2 pairs each playing 2 sets against each pair.
Matches must be played on or before the dates given by the organisers.
- **Team Tennis** – 1 ladies' and 1 men's team team - 4 ladies' and 3 men's teams - 6 players (3 pairs) each playing a best-of-3-sets rubber against their equivalent pair, 3rd set being a championship tie break, and a single-set rubber against the other two pairs.
Matches must be played on or before the dates given by the organisers.
- **Herts Doubles League** - 4 ladies' and 3 men's teams - 4 ladies' and 3 men's teams - 6 players (3 pairs) each playing a best-of-3-sets rubber against their equivalent pair, 3rd set being a championship tie break, and a single-set rubber against the other two pairs.
Matches are arranged by the team captains.
- **Hot Rackets Doubles League** - 3 ladies' and 3 men's teams - 4 players (2 pairs) each playing 2 best-of-2-sets doubles rubbers.
Match dates are provided by the organisers.

Summer Leagues - midweek

- **Watford & District** – 2 ladies', 3 men's and 3 mixed teams - 6 players (3 pairs) each playing 3 single-set rubbers.
Match dates are provided by the organisers.

Winter Leagues - weekend

- **Herts Doubles Vets League** – 2 Ladies' Over 40s, 2 Ladies over 50s, 2 Men's over 45s and 2 Men's over 55s - 4 players (2 pairs) each playing 2 doubles rubbers of 2 sets each.
Matches are arranged by the team captains.
