Tie-Break Shootout Tournament Rules

1. The Tie-break Shootout is a separate singles event for both Men and Women.
2. The Tie-Break Shootout will be played fully on one day, including finals and semi-finals, though the Tournament Committee reserve the right to make alternative arrangements in exceptional circumstances, e.g. bad weather.
3. The Tournament Committee's decision is final on all matters.
4. All players must be a full member of the tennis club prior to entering the tournament.
5. All matches are tie-breaks. The length of these tie-breaks will be decided by the Tournament Committee, dependent on player numbers.
6. Players will likely be split into 2 groups, playing other participants in a round robin format. The Tournament Committee exercises the right to alter the format, dependent on player numbers.
7. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to amend or review any of the above as it sees fit, even during a tournament.
